

THE Wilgrims Wath

Come away and walk the pilgrims path with us.

Join us on a mindful walk which embraces the stories of Celtic Mythology and Spirituality.

We are taking time to step into tune with nature and listen to the land. We will share traditional stories and rituals associated with the sacred sites along the pilgrimage.

As a pre-Christian and Christian deity, Brigid has a rich history and presence in Ireland. The route is based on Brigid's pilgrim route of Brigid from her birthplace in Faughart. We follow the wells and waters, such as the Boyne River, that for centuries have been places of gathering for our ancestors.

We will spend time on the sacred site of the Hill of Tara and end the walk at the Brigid's Fire Temple and wells in the town of Kildare.

Brigid is associated with the elements of poetry, healing, midwifery & smithing and these elements will be weaved in as part of the rituals that will take place throughout the walk.

This walk will really speak to you if you have a "grá" or yearning to really spend time in nature and connect with your indigenous Celtic heritage,

The walk is facilitated by 3 leaders and Brigid enthuasiasts Bebhinn, Muireann and Tracey. They have designed this walk and will both lead the group and facilitate the rituals each day. They will be joined by special guests for activities that will happen during the 5 day walk.
